PROGRAM REVIEW TIMELINE

- Program Proposal is received and confirmed by ISBE prep staff
- IHE can request either a *peer review or ISBE review
 - *Peer review granted 1 full months for review.
 - ISBE review 2-4 week turnaround
- ISBE will send IHE review matrix with areas Met or Not Met.
- Institution may modify proposal per review matrix and submit for posting on a SEPLB agenda or IHE may ask for another review of modified changes per review matrix.
- ISBE submits final proposal to be added to next available SEPLB agenda
 - Final proposals MUST be received two weeks prior to scheduled SEPLB meeting
 - Proposals are added on a **first-come, first-serve** basis.

** Peer review is required for all Principal and Superintendent Preparation Programs*

Peer Review is optional for Early Childhood, Elementary and Middle Grades Preparation Program

MIDDLE GRADES:

- January 31, 2018-Last day to **apply/entitle** for 5-8 or 6-8 Middle School (18+6)
 - 1 year to apply for ENT
 - 2 FYs to meet any deficiencies (June 30, 2020)
- February 1, 2018-5-8 Middle Grades programs become effective (21+3)
 - 25 Traditional MG Programs (4 Core Areas)
 - 2 Alternative MG Programs (4 Core Areas)
 - 1 IHE-MG Fast Track for French/Art/Spanish

ELS-PIDU:

- Bachelors Degree
- Completed/passed everything in EPP but **edTPA**
 - Basic Skills
 - Content Test
 - Student Teaching
- Minimum Passing score on edTPA
 - Remain 3 points below the current cut score
- Issue via entitlement **ONLY**
 - Optional

ESL/BIL STANDARDS:

- September 1, 2018
 - Approved teacher prep programs that offer coursework and clinical experiences leading to the receipt of an ESL/BIL endorsement shall submit the course of study for ESL/BIL endorsements to align with standards in Part 27.425
- Coursework/field experience requirement will remain the same
- ESL/BIL Matrix found online
- Bilingual courses shall align to 27.425 (a) and (b)

REDESIGN OF SECONDARY PROGRAMS:

- October 1, 2020- No candidate shall be admitted into an “Old” (6-12) program, additionally this date would be the date that “New” (9-12) programs may become effective.
- October 1, 2024- “Old” (6-12) Programs must be completed
- October 1, 2025-Candidates must be entitled for “Old” (6-12) program
